This event picks up on the tradition of the Akademie der Künste's "Berliner Begegnungen zur Friedensförderung", which took place in the early 1980s. In 1981, at the initiative of essayist and poet Stephan Hermlin, the East German Akademie der Künste invited some 100 writers, artists and scholars from East and West Germany and other European countries to discuss the threat to peace in East and West. In 1983, members of the Literature Section of the Akademie der Künste in West Berlin, including Günter Grass, Walter Höllerer and Uwe Johnson, organised the Second Berlin Encounter.
